TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. Participation in this event is open to all Lower Eastern Shore USBC members (Youth included, but bear in mind that alcoholic beverages will be present). This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress with all honor scores being recognized as valid. LES USBC memberships may be purchased on site.

2. All players will receive a 90% handicap on the basis of the difference between 220 and their average. No negative handicaps will be awarded. All averages will be based off of the following (in order):

- A. Highest 21+ game LES USBC average from the 2010-2011 fall league season.
- B. Highest 21+ game average from a USBC fall league in another association for the 2010-2011 fall season.
- C. Highest 21+ game average from a USBC 2011 summer league season.
- D. Highest 21+ game average from a 2011-2012 USBC fall league (proper documentation must be shown).

All others will bowl scratch.

3. All participants will bowl three games with the highest score with handicap being declared the winner. An additional tenth frame will be bowled in the event of a tie for first place. This will happen again as needed until there is a winner.

All participants are encouraged to arrive at least 30 minutes early. Walk-in entries will be accepted so long as space is available. Registering early is strongly advised as we have but 12 lanes at our disposal. We will not be putting more than six bowlers on a lane.

The winner will receive a "USBC Bowl for the Cure" pink bowling pin as well as an invitation to the Lower Eastern Shore USBC Awards Banquet.

4. USBC Rules #319a2 (10 pin up rule), 319d (reporting prize winnings) and 319e (average adjustments) are waived for this tournament.

5. Pacers will not be permitted. Any pre-registered bowler arriving late may receive zero score for frames missed. Pre-registered bowlers have the right to transfer their entry to another eligible bowler in the event that they cannot attend.

6. The entry fee for this event is \$30. Fees breakdown as follows:

\$10.50 – Cherokee Lanes (We thank Cherokee for offering us this discounted glow bowl rate)

\$19.50 – Donation to USBC/Susan G. Komen Foundation "Bowl for the Cure" fund

There will be no cash prizes awarded for this tournament. Youth bowlers are encouraged to participate as this event is within the boundaries of USBC Rule #400.

7. Tournament management reserves the right to eject any player behaving in an unacceptable fashion. Such persons are subject to banishment from future LES USBC events as deemed fit.
